I would like to thank everyone that has taken the time to give us feedback through the community survey that was sent out in June. We had a 24% return rate which doesn't sound all that good, but in the survey world I understand it to be fantastic. Seventy percent of survey respondents reported they were either very satisfied or satisfied with the school district. Additionally, the community gave positive rankings to the district for providing a safe and welcoming learning environment, building pride in the community, delivering a high-quality education and maintaining facilities.

After analyzing the results further and several discussions later the Board of Education has agreed to pursue a referendum for this November. The survey indicated that there is little support for the community fitness center. The board has taken that information to heart and have decided to address the remainder of the projects in two questions.

School safety, adding a choral room and weight room and updating the FACE and Band rooms will be the topic of one question while the second will ask the voters to decide on an additional gymnasium.

The board is now in the planning stages to educate the community on the need and benefits to our students, school and community. Please be on the lookout for opportunities to gain more information.




