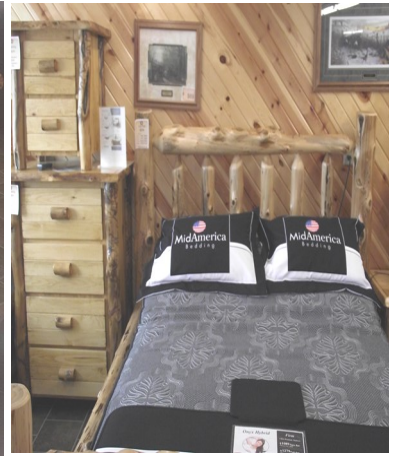

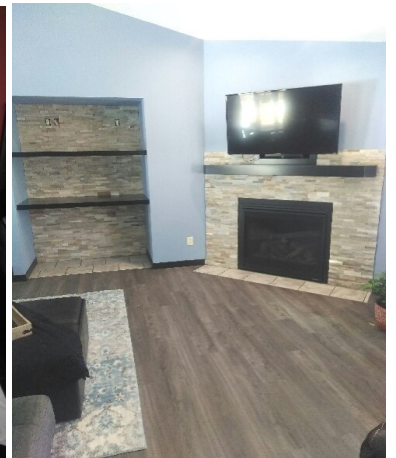
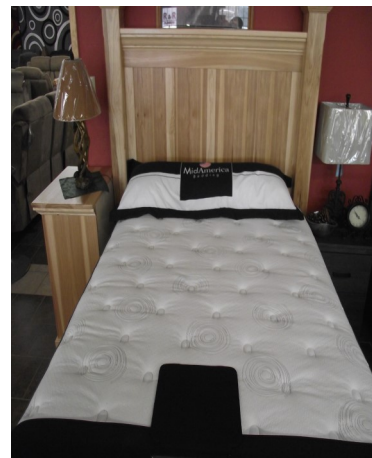

They moved into the old bowling alley building in 2004. It was more of a trip down memory lane as I vividly remember just where the pool table sat, and the juke box. I could practically hear pins crash into the back of the alleys or smell burgers and onions coming from Charlie and Bobby Wenzel's kitchen. But Pat and Al have transformed the place, replacing bowling lanes with work benches and tables and ball returns with sewing machines.

Our visit a couple weeks later was more about shooting the breeze than anything else. Seems that the owners of Bear Creek Canvas are just a couple of long time friends from Loyal who wanted to be in business together some day. I told them I did my student teaching in Loyal so long ago it wasn't true anymore and we exchanged stories of teachers and other folks we both knew, from different angles. It felt as if I'd known them a long time.

It became abundantly clear through talking with them and getting a tour through their operation that their attention to detail is what has gotten them this far. That's evidenced by the dozens of testimonials of satisfied customers on their website.

I've never had a camper and I'm not sure if I'm going to have one but if I need to kill a half hour and have a couple laughs I figure I can always stop at the old bowling alley.

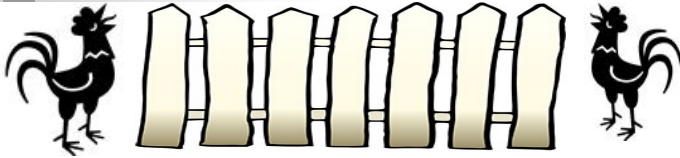
