Hello,

I just wanted to recap what Troy and I decided to do for Basketball. Most items are the same as last year but a couple things are new.

- 1. We will have a registration night on October 18th. I will create a FB event once Troy confirms we can use the HS commons and deliver the registration forms to school.
- 2. We should not need any equipment this year.
- 3. We might need to order a few Jersey's depending on sizes but most likely have enough as we ordered extra.
- 4. Becky has sent another email to Adam Decker about the camp dates. Steve and I discussed Saturdays in October however Oct 6th is Homecoming so that date was not available. We'll just do 3 dates 9:30 to 10:30 for the 1st to 3rd graders and 4th to 8th from 10:45 to 12:30.
 - a. Fee is \$20
 - b. No shirts we are giving a water bottle and cinch bag to get rid of the ones we had from Brad Bauer. This way we don't have to order anything:)
 - c. Registration forms will be mailed to Jeana and she is going to take care of all registration and make the deposits into our account.
- 5. Troy will get the list of Saturday's we can have home games and provide to the league.
 - a. Troy will fill out the forms to open the doors from 7am to 8:00 pm.
 - b. We will have league games and then try to get some 4th grade games in.
- 6. Troy will reserve the school gym space Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday from 6 to 9 and Sunday 4 to 6.
 - a. Becky will coordinate times with coaches so they don't overlap
- 7. Becky will schedule volunteer times for parents like what we did for Baseball. They can find their own replacements.
- 8. Becky will plan to set up concessions each time but may need Trish/Sandy to clean up.
- 9. Tracey will get the perishables and soda for games
- 10. Fee for league is going to be \$60 but we WILL NOT ask parents to bring any concessions items. We did ask for volunteers to donate or at least make bake sale things. My hope is to find a parent to make puppy chow each home game, and rice Krispy treats each time etc so we don't have to "plan" we know they'll just come. We can buy stuff from Kristies Kakes and Sam's club too... even if it's prepackaged it will be fine.
 - a. Jeana will log registrations on our spreadsheet.
- 11. We are targeting January 19th and 20th to do a 7th and 8th grade Tourney. We will need volunteers for this one but will ask the girls basketball to help. We can donate some money back to their program as they are saving for Jersey's. We can probably ask them to do book and scoreboard too. We will take 6 teams for each grade for each day. \$100 entry and get ribbons not metals.
- 12. Troy makes sure there are refs and plans to be available at all home games.
- 13. We discussed the teams and how last year went with coaches:
 - a. 4th grade girls: Casey Krause/Dave Knecht both interested
 - b. 4th Boy's: ??? I don't know yet until I see who signs up for boys.
 - c. 5th Girls: might have to combine with 4th (this is fine cuz then 4th grade gets more playing time)
 - d. 5th Boy's: Jason Miller (this was a big 4th grade team last year)
 - e. 6th Girls; Dave and Brooke
 - f. 6th Boys: Justin Knecht and Al
- 14. The deposit for volunteer/jersey is \$40
