Offered to children entering K through 4th Grade who are new to baseball or would like to improve skills. The program is run camp style to teach the basics. Tee ball is held at the ARC Park on June 6th, 13th, 20th, 27th, and July 11th. 5:45 to 6:30. Players will receive a shirt and the fee is \$30.

Please have your child bring a glove each night. If you do not want your child using shared helmets we recommend that you buy your own. It is required that helmets are worn while batting.

8U Pre-Team Baseball 7 and 8 year olds:

Pre-Team Baseball is for children entering 2nd through 5th grade. Children will work on the next level of skills which will prepare them to play league in the future. Skills include pitching, hitting from a pitching machine, baseball rules, and game strategy. We recommend one year of pre-team or league play through other programs prior to signing up for competitive baseball. Pre-team meets at the ARC Park on 6th, 13th, 20th, 27th and July 11th from 6:30 to 7:30. Additional opportunities may be available to practice and will be communicated as time gets closer. Each participant will receive a shirt and the fee is \$40.

Please have your child bring a glove to each night. If you do not want your child using shared helmets we recommend that you buy your own. It is required that helmets are worn while batting.

10U and 12U Travel League:

Players compete against other traveling teams. League is open to boys and girls. Children 8 to 10 years old will play in 10U. Games are Mondays in Spencer and Tuesdays in a neighboring town. 10 to 12 year old's play Tuesdays in Spencer and Wednesday's in a neighboring town. All players will receive a hat. The fee is \$65. A \$60 deposit for Jersey's and Volunteer time will also be collected (pay with separate check post-dated) The check will only be cashed if you do not return your jersey or fulfill your volunteer requirement.

Practices will be throughout the Summer and players need to attempt to attend as much as possible. We recommend one year of pre-team prior to playing competitive baseball to understand the game and its rules. Your child will need a glove, grey baseball pants, and cleats. In the event there are more than players but not enough players for two full teams we will rotate games. This means that your child will not play every game. Most likely they will miss one game every 3 weeks. The program has opted to rotate games rather than hold tryouts as to not discourage kids.

It is very important that you as parents are realistic about your child's skill level. Kids in this league throw and pitch HARD if your child isn't ready an extra year in pre-team will make all the difference.
